New York State requires the following paperwork for students placed in medical settings:

1. Physical exam must be dated within one year of October 9, 2016 for participants.
A statement from your physician that you had a physical will not be accepted.
2. A copy of the student's immunization, to include proof of 2 MMR immunizations on or after first birthday at least 30 days apart or Rubella Titre and Rubeola Titre results.
3. Results of Mantoux TB test (PPD) done within six months of October 9, 2016 for school year participants.
4. Documentation of having received current Influenza Vaccine. For students interning, the required current Influenza Vaccine will be the one available for the Fall of 2016.

You can have a Mantoux test with your own doctor or at the following Health Departments:
